



BOXCAR TRANSPORTATION & EDUCATION PROJECT

The Box Car Transportation & Education Project is arranged on a first come – first serve basis and will be available for a one or two-week period. Due to high demand, schools may not host the boxcar in consecutive years.

Call or e-mail the Education Department to schedule the boxcar, giving three workable dates based on the available schedule. We will try to accommodate the first choice, but that may not always be possible.

- ✓ **2009/2010 requests must be submitted BEFORE October 31, 2009.**
- ✓ **A \$300 booking fee is required upon confirmation.**

HOST SCHOOL

Logistics:

- ✓ *Proper location measuring at least 20 feet x 50 feet*
- ✓ *Space for the truck to maneuver in and detach the low-boy*
- ✓ *Adequate lighting and nighttime security*

Program:

- ✓ *Schedule teacher workshop prior to boxcar arriving*
- ✓ *Day 1 – hold one hour assembly for museum presentation w/ a survivor*
- ✓ *Open House program for parents*
- ✓ *Compile a scrapbook of student reflections, photographs, etc, to be presented to the Holocaust Museum*

MUSEUM

Logistics:

- ✓ *Arrange & oversee transportation*
- ✓ *Set up accompanying exhibit*

Program:

- ✓ *Provide 1-hour teacher workshop prior to boxcar arrival*
- ✓ *Provide educators' guide with appropriate teaching activities & scrapbook*
- ✓ *Facilitate opening assembly*
- ✓ *Assist with open house night for parents*
